PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Pickett, Kelm & Associates provided structural engineering services for this 10,900 square foot gymnsium. The project included 7,800 square feet of competition area and 1,550 square feet each of boys and girls locker room facilities. The project included a rainwater collection system.

The gymnasium structure consists of a pre-engineered metal building. The floor consists of a concrete



ground-supported slab over compacted select fill, with sealed, exposed concrete floors in the locker area. The building foundation consists



of grade beams with drilled shafts to limestone at the columns. Exterior cladding consists of a combination of metal siding, insulated translucent sandwich panels and natural limestone masonry.
